REGULATING PUBLIC EXHIBITIONS IN THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same, That from and after the passage of this ordinance no public exhibitions shall be held without a license first had and obtained from the Chief Burgess, or in his absence the President of Town Council.

Sec. 2. The Chief Burgess and in his absence the President of the Town Council is hereby authorized and empowered to grant licenses of said exhibitions of a proper character, upon receipt from the Treasurer that he has received from the applicant or applicants, the sums required by this ordinance for licenses of said exhibitions. And said receipt the Burgess or President shall file and produce before the Auditors at the settlement of the Treasurer's accounts.

All exhibitions shall rate as follows, viz: Each and every circus per day Ten Dollars; theaters and Ethiopian serenades per day Two Dollars and fifty cents. Local exhibitions, scientific lectures, religious entertainments shall require no license.

Sec. 3. Each and every person offending against the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit and pay for every offence the sum of not less than Five Dollars no more than One Hundred dollars to be recovered as debts of like amount are recoverable by law and paid into the Treasury for the use of the Borough.
