FOR THE BETTER REGULATION OF THE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS
IN THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE

Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same;

That from and after the publication of this ordinance all persons owning or occupying property in any of the streets of the Borough of Millville whose grades have been laid out and the same adopted by resolution of the Town Council of the Borough aforesaid or which may hereafter be laid out and accepted by the same, shall have their pavements made in accordance with the following regulations which are hereby declared to be general.

Sec. 1. That the grade of the pavements or foot walks on all streets be uniform in accordance with the grade fixed and established by the engineer and approved by the Town Council and that whenever any new pavements are erected, laid or constructed or any now laid are being repaired, the same shall be laid to conform to the grade fixed by the Borough surveyor.

Sec. 2. A gutter of suitable width shall be paved outside the curb line, with round stone, the bottom of gutter to be sufficient depth below the level of the pavement to give proper drainage to the street as the engineer shall direct.

Sec. 3. That no person shall set or cause to be set any curb stone or pave or cause to be paved any gutter or gutters or cause to be made any pavement or pavements in any street until the place thereof shall be given by the Town Surveyor or other person appointed by Council to do so.

Sec. 4. The expense of grading, curbing, paving and guttering shall be borne by the property holders, in front of whose lot or lots the same shall be done, and any person who shall make or cause to be made any pavement or shall pave or cause to be paved any gutter contrary to the provisions of this ordinance shall, on conviction forfeit

and pay a fine of Ten Dollars for every such offense.

Sec. 5. Whenever the Town Council shall direct that pavements shall be laid on any street in the Borough of Millville and the owner or owners of lots or land along which such pavements are to be laid, refuse or neglect to lay such pavements for thirty days after having been notified by the Street Commissioner, that then and in such cases the Town Council will proceed to cause the said pavements to be laid and the cost thereof with twenty per centum added thereto to be collected from the owner or owners of said lots as debts of like amounts are recoverable by law.

Sec. 6. That each and every person or persons owning lots or land on either side of any of the streets in said Borough, herein maned between the points herein specified viz: On Main Street between the western line of said Borough and Chestnut, on east side of State Street between Main and Fourth Streets. On the west side of State Street between Main and John Eves' Wagon Factory, and on the north side of Morehead Avenue between. State Street and the W & W R'y be and are hereby required within thirty days from date of this ordinance to lay new pavements or repair those already laid where such repairs are necessary, upon being notified so to do by the Street Commissioner. The said pavements to be such width as directed by the Town Council and that the said pavements or walks be made with stone, plank, brick or cement.
