AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE FEES AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN
BOROUGH OFFICERS.

Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same.

Sec. 1. That the fees of Chief Burgess when acting in his capacity of magistrate shall be as follows:

For every information or complaint, every ten words \$.02
For docket entry of any case before him for hearing .20
For warrant of arrest or commitment .40
For administrative oath or affirmation .10
For taking recognizance .20
For subpoena for witness .20
For hearing a case when complaint shall be dismissed without a trial or examination of witness .20
For hearing a case on trial and entering judgement .40
For warrant to levy a fine on forfeiture .40
For an official or certified copy of any paper or record, for every ten words .02

Sec. 2. The fees and allowance to the High Constable for services and outlay shall be as follows:

For an arrest for each person and taking before the Chief Burgess \$.50
For serving subpoena, one person .20
For each additional after the first .10
Serving fine of forfeiture on warrant .30
Taking or holding in custody after conviction to prison .50
For travelling in executing process, per mile circular .06
For necessary support of persons arrested or held by him in custody such amounts as may be reasonably expended by him to be taxed and allowed by the Chief Burgess.
