AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 18 IN RELATION TO THE LOCATION AND WIDTH OF MAIN STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE FROM THE INTERSECTION OF GREEN STREET TO THE FORKS OF THE STREETS NEAR WILLIAM KINGSTON'S.

Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same;

Sec. 1 That the location of Main Street from the intersection of Green Street to the forks of the streets near the house of William Kingston, shall be as follows: Beginning at the center stone at the intersection of Green Street thence north fifty-four degrees east four hundred and twenty-eight feet to the middle of Chestnut street; thence north fifty-one degrees and fifty-four minutes east seven hundred and sixty-five feet; thence north fifty-four degrees and fifty minutes east one hundred and thirty-two feet to the stone at the forks of the streets near William Kingston's.

Sec. 2. That the width of Main Street from the eastern side of the Public School lot and the western side of William E. Johnson's lot eastward shall be thirty-nine feet. The side or foot walk shall be four feet wide.

Sec. 3. That the changes made by this ordinance in the line of Main Street shall be indicated by the lines in red ink on the Borough map which is a part of ordinance 18.

Sec. 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore passed by Council that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
