

19041003.029 Repealing Sections 5 and 6 of Ordinance 17

No. XXIX

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 5 AND 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. XII OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Chief Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Millville and is hereby enacted by authority of the same, that Sections 5 and 6 of Ordinance No. XII of the Borough of Millville be and are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Whenever the Town Council shall direct that pavements shall be laid on any street in the Borough of Millville, where walks have not before been laid, and the owner or owners of lots or land along which such pavements are to be laid, refuse or neglect to lay such pavements for thirty days after having been duly notified by the Street Commissioner, that then and in such cases the Town Council will proceed to cause such pavements to be laid, and the cost thereof, with twenty per centum added thereto, to be collected from the owner or owners of said lots as debts of like amount are recoverable by law, said walk to be of plank, brick, stone or cement.

Sec. 3. Whenever walks have been laid on any of the streets of the Borough of Millville, by authority of Council or otherwise, it shall be the duty of owner or owners of such properties to keep said walks in good repair, and in case they shall neglect or refuse to keep them in safe and passable condition it is hereby made the duty of the Street Commissioner, when so directed by Council, to notify the owner or owners of such property to repair said walks, or to relay them if necessary, and in case such owner or owners neglect or refuse to comply with such notice within Ten days, the Council shall through the Street Commissioner proceed to repair or relay said walk at the expense of the owner or owners of such property, and collect the cost thereof from such owner or owners in the manner provided in Sections 2 of this Ordinance.
