AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE, COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A PLANNING COMMISSION PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPALITIES PLANNING CODE, 1968 JULY 31, P.L. NO. 247, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ENACTED by the Borough Council of Millville Borough, Columbia County, Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. The Borough Council of Millville Borough, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, shall and they hereby do create a Planning Commission for Millville Borough, Columbia County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. There shall be five members of such Commission, all of whom shall be residents of Millville Borough, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and shall be appointed by Council. In the first instance one member of said Commission shall be appointed for one year, and one member for two years, one member for three years, one member for four years, and one member for five years, and annually thereafter, a member of said Commission shall be appointed for a term of five years.

SECTION 3. Any member of a planning commission once qualified and appointed may be removed from office for malfeasance, misfeasance or non-feasance in office or for other just cause by a majority vote of the governing body which appointed the member, taken after the member has received fifteen days' advance notice of intent to take such a vote. A hearing shall be held in connection with the vote if the member shall request it in writing. Appointment to fill a vacancy created by removal shall be only for the unexpired term.

SECTION 4. The Planning Commission so appointed shall organize in accordance with the terms of the Act, make rules and regulations to cover its procedures not inconsistent with the Ordinances of the municipality and laws of the Commonwealth; maintain a full record of its business; and shall annually make a written report by March 1, of each year of its activities to the Borough Council and make such interim reports as may be requested by the Borough Council.

SECTION 5. The Commission shall have all the powers and be subject to all of the duties expressly given or imposed upon them by the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 1968 July 31, PL No. 247, as amended.

SECTION 6. Severability Clause. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provision or part thereof shall be held invalid or unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such invalidity, unconstitutionality of inapplicability shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions of the act.

This Ordinance shall be come effective five days following it adoption.
