AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE HEIGHT OF NUISANCE PLANT GROWTH IN
THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE, COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the
Council of the Borough of Millville that:

All weeds, noxious weeds, brush, poisonous vines, or grass growing upon any lot or between the property line and the street or curb line and streets, or along the sides of property, in the Borough of Millville, about to ripen into seed, or over eight (8) inches in height, are hereby declared a public nuisance and abatable as such. Any person or persons, firm or corporation, either as principal or agent, or tenant, or owner of property containing such weeds, brush, vines or grass, within five (5) days from date of said notice from the Mayor or administrator, he or she shall be charged with violating this ordinance, and the Mayor or Administrator is hereby authorized, directed, and required to cause said weeds, brush, poisonous vines or grass to be cut and collect the costs thereof with penalties according to the Acts of assembly in such case made and provided.

This ordinance does not apply to land used for farming, woodlands, or wetlands.

Any person or persons, firm or corporation, whether owner or tenant, maintaining a public nuisance as declared in this ordinance and neglecting or refusing to comply with this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10.00 or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than 30 days, plus costs. Each day that a violation of this ordinance continues shall constitute, a separate offense. Conviction and sentencing shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable and if any provisions herein shall be held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as legislative intent that this ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional, invalid, or illegal provision not been included herein.
