ORDINANCE NUMBER 111 (1992)

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE, COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.01 OF ORDINANCE 110, ALL PERSONS IMPORTING SEWAGE GENERATED FROM WITHOUT THE LIMITS OF THE BOROUGH OF MILLVILLE TO OBTAIN A PERMIT BEFORE DISCHARGING SUCH SEWAGE INTO THE BOROUGH'S SEWER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Sewage Treatment Plant of the Borough of Millville is regulated by the Department of Environmental Resources of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, AND WHEREAS, those regulations control both the quantity and the quality of the effluent from that sewage treatment plant, AND

WHEREAS, sewage being generated outside the Borough's Control, imported to the Borough and discharged into the Borough's sewage system through Recreational Vehicles, Commercial Sewage Disposal Firms or by any other could significantly increase the Borough's cost of treatment and cause the borough to be in violation of environmental regulations, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that any organization, person or persons seeking to discharge sewage generated from outside the Borough's limits into the Borough's sewers or any resident of the Borough or Organization conducting activities within the Borough allowing such to be done shall first obtain a permit, in writing, from the Sewage Treatment Superintendent or assistant Superintendent.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment and shall remain in force until rescinded by ordinance.
