ORDINANCE NO. 19961217.138 Driveways

WHEREAS, installation of new driveways can affect the property of others, the quality of drainage, the condition of sidewalks, the surface of Boro streets and roadways, and

WHEREAS, The Boro Council of Millville, hereinafter the Boro, wishing to contain costs and provide for harmony in the community, now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1. That before any driveway is constructed across a sidewalk, through any curb, intersect with any Boro street, alley or roadway within the limits of the Boro; any person, partnership, corporation or other chartered entity, public or private, hereinafter the owner, shall be required to apply for a driveway permit and a final certificate of inspection for the completed driveway on forms supplied by the Boro. The fee for such permit shall be five (5) dollars or such fee as prescribed by resolution in the future.

- Section 2. All driveways, public or private, constructed across any sidewalk, drainage area, curb or intersects with a public street, alley or roadway, hereinafter the cartway, shall be laid out according to the specifications supplied by the Boro at the time the permit is granted.
- Section 3. Any invasion of the pavement of a sidewalk, curb or cartway shall be restored to an appropriate configuration specified by the permit.
- Section 4. In the event of a violation of the requirements of this Ordinance, the Boro may order the person to remove any improper work and replace it with compliant work. Notice to remove improper work shall be given by registered or certified mail or delivered by an officer of the law setting forth a limit of forty-five (45) days from receipt of notice for

abatement of the violation. After that time the Boro may do or cause the requested abatement to be done and may levy the cost of its work as a property lien to be collected in any manner provided by law.

Section 7. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent.

Section 8. The invalidity of any part of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance.
