

DRUG TASK FORCE ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19970121.140

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BORO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CERTAIN OTHER MUNICIPALITIES IN COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND SETTING FORTH THE FORM OF AGREEMENT, WHICH WILL GOVERN THE RELATIONSHIP

WHEREAS, the Boro Council of the Boro of Millville, hereinafter the Boro, seeks to enhance the coordination of drug investigations in the Columbia County area, AND;

WHEREAS, in pursuit of that effort, the Boro seeks to provide for mutual aid across jurisdictional lines to enable police to more effectively enforce the provisions of narcotics and illegal drug laws thereby preserving the safety and welfare of the entire area; AND

WHEREAS, in further pursuit, the Boro seeks to have available for use throughout the territorial limits of all municipalities joining in the agreement, the services of police employed by any and all of the said municipalities, under the conditions set forth in compliance with the Municipal Police Jurisdictional Act, 42 PA C.S.A. Section 8953.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, Boro Council of the Boro of Millville, County of Columbia and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section I The Boro shall enter into a Municipal Drug Task Force Agreement, hereinafter the agreement, with certain other municipalities located in Columbia County, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Office of the Attorney General, Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Drug Control, hereinafter OAG, such Agreement to conform substantially to the Agreement attached hereto and made part hereof as Exhibit "A."

Section II The duration of the Agreement shall be indefinite, subject to termination by any municipality or OAG as provided therein.

Section III The Agreement shall be financed by grants, donations and money furnished by OAG and the Office of the District Attorney of Columbia County.

Section IV A Joint Police Advisory Board had been organized to implement the mutual aid agreement referred to in Paragraph 5 of the Agreement.

Section V All property owned by participating municipalities shall remain the property of such municipalities, and any property acquired by the Joint Police Advisory Board shall be managed and disposed of by the Board and the Columbia county District Attorney.

Section VI All Ordinances and Resolution or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section VII This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its adoption as provided by law.
